

- 2 stations left net early


Takeaways:

- Plan to vary drill times







Outreach: Pathfinders Presentation

Logistics



- All equipment is functioning
- Equipment assigned and stored at the Lee County Public Safety Center:
 - Equipment being moved to Storage Bay (B17/B18) Purchase of larger PVC pipe to accommodate masts and other tall items is being considered
 - Go-Boxes and Hamaid Kit will be moved to the Technology Room from the Tower Room when ready.
 - Inventory will be ongoing of all LeeARES equipment
- Repeater 146.685 still awaiting action, but the process has begun
- Awaiting action on the antenna cable situation at Hertz Arena
- Updating cable connections to antennas that may have changed in the PSC Amateur Radio Room

Training



- Winlink drills continue We learned through the most recent drill that AT&T has stopped the ability for us to send text messages using Winlink Express in June 2025.
- Practice for activations on your own by setting up and using your equipment at a remote location.
- Continue working on Task Book items.
- We are in the beginning stages of planning for a SET in October (More information to follow).


