



2025 Simulated Emergency Test S.E.T.

Date: Saturday, October 4

• Time: 0900-1200

- Purpose: Simulate activation and deployment for an approaching storm.
- 20 ARES members signed up and will have roles assigned in advance
- Coming soon: ICS-201 and ICS-205



2025 SET: What to expect & Ground Rules



- Signal app will announce the 'activation', ask for more participants, and deliver assignments.
- There will be a delay initially as assignments are determined
- Roles: Shelter, NCS, Field operator (work from home)
- 'Injects': simulate actual messages and will be delivered via Signal or text.
- YOU will decide how to send message traffic: phone or digital.
- Employ your emergency power plan if possible.
- Document your activity using form ICS-214 (need for hotwash)

HEY FIRST RESPONDERS-ARE YOU "READY TO ROLL"?

- How is your present Skill Set? Are you both competent & confident? Is your training current & complete? Are you actively participating in each & every ARES Drill?
- Have you achieved ARES Level 1 or 2, and ready for deployment to a disaster shelter? Are you ready to be a Color Zone Net Control Station? [For a natural or man-made disaster/comms crisis].
- Have you taken the required and recommended FEMA and ARRL courses? Is your CPR/First Aid/AED training certificate valid (within/in last 2 yrs)?
- Are you "Ready to Roll" to save lives (Human & animal) and protect property?



"Safety" Test Question:

- Question: During a Lee County Shelter <u>hurricane</u> deployment, you overhear radio traffic stating: "Attention all stations, Lee County EMS and Fire are <u>Condition Red</u>."
- What does this mean?
- Answer: The hurricane peak winds have achieved or exceeded 45 mph, and no agency's EMS and Fire/Rescue are responding to ANY calls for assistance. You are on your own!
